

REPORT

A inspection of ABC center was carried out at Mira Bhaynder Municipal Corporation. Tge tender has been allotted to Prataprao Rane Samajik Shaikshanik Trust a Maharashtra based NGO. The inspection team constituted to investigate the issue consisted of the following members:-

Team visited Animal Birth Control Center, at Mira Bhaynder on 22nd July 2025.

The findings as follows:-

1. Complaint received by Mr. Ravindra Babasaheb Kharat regarding renewal of contract to run this facility to trust by veterinary department of MBMC and alleged that there is huge corruption for granting in experienced trust. Also blaming that veterinary officer is not maintaining movement register not following office protocol.
2. MBMC renewed contract with Prataprao Rane Samajik Shaikshanik Trust for conducting Animal Birth control Programme with due legal process in March 2025.
3. At Animal Birth Control facility above mentioned trust carrying sterilization of stray dogs. Following yearly data presented before team as follows

2022-23 2419

2023-24 4177

2024-25 3193

On the basis of previous record of good conduct of running facility the renewal contract had been done by MBMC in good faith of law justified by Dr. Vikram Niratale, Veterinary officer employed by MBMC.

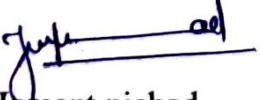
4. On perusal of contract agreement papers came to conclusion that the procedure of awarding contract followed all administrative and legal procedure.
5. As veterinary officer is employed by MBMC a field job administrative supervisory role is of Deputy Municipal Commissioner. This issue is out of our teams domain.
6. At the site of ABC facility team inspected following records
7. Employee role attendance muster. Facility having 6 employees out which 2 livestock supervisors, 2 catchers, 1 supervisor, 1 manager. Was maintained from may to till today.
8. Veterinary Surgeon Dr Mayur Shilwant Reg No. MSVC 9644 was present at facility.
9. Facility have catching van No MH04MH1439 in good condition.
10. Facility have capacity of 100 cages for dogs, at the time of inspection 46 dogs were present.
11. There is no isolation/quarantine ward available at facility.
12. Feeding register available. Data mentioned in register have variable around 4-7 kg per day.
13. Medicine stock book was not maintained properly and legible handwriting. Medicine available at facility and data mentioned in stock book didn't match.
14. Dog catch register and release register didn't get matched and not signed veterinarian.
15. Operation register not maintained properly, there was entry of feline species (CAT) operation data entry observed in register so animals cached and released couldn't be matched properly. Upon asking about cat neutering manager told team they are also

- running cat sterilization facility at different premises so there is discrepancy in data mentioned in register. Team also found that data mentioned in illegible writing.
16. At the time of visit Operation theatre was under renovation, workers were doing renovation and repair of OT.
17. In operation Theatre there was schedule H drugs were found open and half used which are supposed to be kept in strict cupboard.
There were 9 kitamin vials half used seen in open tray,(batch No.KMI24004, mfg dt 11/24, Exp dt 8/27
Inj. Ondem 30ml(Mfg dt 7/23 Exp.6/25)
Inj. Adchrome (Mfg dt 5/23, Exp.dt 4/25)
Inj. Antirabies Brilient 10ml 10 no. (batch no. 08RV22001, Mfg dt 3/22, Exp.dt 2/25)
Inj. Rasix 2ml(Mfg dt 12/22, Exp.dt 11/24)
Inj. Adchrome (Mfg dt 11/22, Exp.dt 10/24)
Inj. Vitamigil 100ml (batch no. SG 2203, Mfg dt 7/23, Exp dt 12/2024)
18. Facility don't have Biowaste(MPCB certification) licence, and fire security (extinguisher)equipment.

RECOMANDATION:-

1. RECORD SHOULD BE KEPT IN LEGIBLE HANDWRING, AND SEPARATE RECORD SHOULD BE MAINTAINED FOR DIFFERENT SPECIES I.E. CANINE AND FELINE AT RESPECTIVE SEPARATE FACILITY.
2. MEDICINE STOCK BOOK SHOULD BE MAINTAINED PROPERLY AT DIFFERENT FACILITY, EXPIRED DRUGS AND VACCINE SHOULD BEDISPOSED OFF WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT.
3. WORK AT CENTER SHOULD SUSPENDED TILL ALL THE COMPLIANCES ARE MET.
4. MONITORING COMMITTEE IS NOT AS PER RULES23 . IT SHOULD BE RECONSTITUTED AND REGULAR VIGLENCE AND MEETINGS SHOULD BE HELD AS PER PROTOCL.


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
